

What is an appraisal notice and why did I receive it?

This document officially notifies you of the proposed value of your property for the current tax year; exemptions that you are receiving and the deadline to file a protest.

The Gregg Appraisal District notifies a property owner of the proposed value of his property if:

The appraised value of the property has changed

The property has been rendered by the owner

The property was not on the appraisal roll in the preceding year

The owner of the property is different from the owner in the preceding year

Ag/Timber valuation has been added or removed

Exemption status has been altered from the preceding year
