## New Deadlines for Business Personal Property Filings

**IMPORTANT: \*Beginning in 2018, the new rendition deadline for all businesses in Gregg County will be April 1<sup>st</sup>.** Changes made during the 85<sup>th</sup> Legislative Session\*\* now require that renditions and property reports are due to the Gregg County Appraisal District ***on or before April 1<sup>st</sup>*** of each tax year. On written request by the property owner, the Chief Appraiser shall extend the deadline for filing a rendition statement or property report to May 1<sup>st</sup> if requested by the original deadline date of April 1<sup>st</sup>. The Chief Appraiser may further extend the deadline an additional 15 days for good cause shown in writing by the property owner if filed by the extended deadline date of May 1<sup>st</sup>. If a business fails to render or if the rendition is turned in after the deadline date, there will be a 10% penalty on the property owner's tax bill for the current year.

\*This change can be found in Texas Property Tax Code Section 22.23(c).
