New Deadlines for Business Personal Property Filings

IMPORTANT: Changes now require that renditions and property reports are due to the Gregg County Appraisal District *on or before April 15th* of each tax year. On written request by the property owner, the Chief Appraiser shall extend the deadline for filing a rendition statement or property report to May 15th, if requested by the original deadline date of April 15th. The Chief Appraiser may further extend the deadline an additional 15 days to May 30th for good cause shown in writing by the property owner, if filed by the extended deadline date of May 15th. If a business fails to render or if the rendition is turned in after the deadline date, there will be a 10% penalty on the property owner's tax bill for the current year.
